


What is the Valley Rural Collaborative?

The Valley Rural Collaborative is a first-of-its-kind partnership among Lake Arthur Schools, Hagerman Municipal Schools, and Eastern New Mexico University – Roswell, led by the Education Partnership of the Permian Basin (EPPB). This innovative initiative is transforming rural education in Southeast New Mexico by creating shared, high-quality college and career pathways tailored to local workforce needs.

In partnership with Empower Schools and Steady State Impact, the Collaborative is launching two workforce-aligned pathways—each housed at a different district but open to students across both districts:



Students will take courses across districts—virtually and in person—giving them access to robust, industry-informed programming regardless of their home school. Each pathway includes work-based learning, mentorship, and industry credentials, preparing students for high-demand careers and future leadership roles in their local communities.

By sharing resources and expertise, the Valley Rural Collaborative is breaking down barriers that rural schools often face and building a sustainable, regional model of equity, opportunity, and innovation.

The Software and Programming program gives students hands-on opportunities to create, modify, and test the codes, forms, and scripts that allow computer applications to run. The skills developed in this pathway can be used in a variety of fields, including medical, industrial, military, communications, aerospace, business, scientific, and general computer applications.
